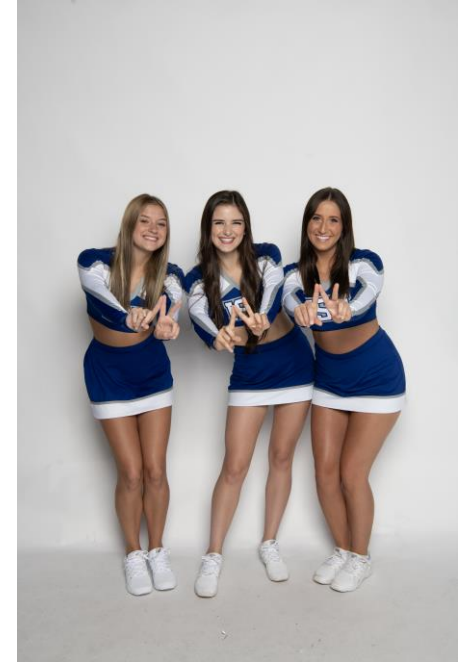

Selection Criteria

- Individuals planning on majoring in business at Indiana State University are eligible for this scholarship.
- Student must meet 1 of the 3 following academic requirements:
 - Ranking in the top 15% of senior class
 - Cumulative GPA of a 3.5 on a 4.0 scale
 - 1140 SAT (Evidence-Based Reading and Writing and Math) or 23 ACT
- Deadlines
 - Students must be accepted to the university by December 1, 2022
 - Students must complete the Networks application on the Branch by December 15, 2022



Application Process

- Apply to Indiana State University at www.indstate.edu/apply
 - Must be accepted to ISU by December 1st.
- Once accepted, the Networks Scholarship Application will be completed electronically on the Branch
 - Ensure all required materials are received by the December 15th deadline.
- Candidates selected will be invited to interview in February 2023



Other Scholarships Explained

The Gongaware Scholarship
(\$9,000/year + \$3,000 Professional Development Account)

Gongaware Scholarship:
Students must be admitted as an incoming freshman to Indiana State University by December 1, 2022 and complete the application by December 15, 2022. This scholarship has the same requirements as Networks (1 of the 3):

1. Ranking in the top 15% of senior class
2. Cumulative GPA of a 3.5 on a 4.0 scale
3. 1140 SAT (Evidence-Based Reading and Writing and Math) or 23 ACT

The Warren M. Anderson Scholarship
(Full in-state tuition)

Warren M. Anderson Scholarship:
Students must be admitted to the University by February 1 and have a cumulative grade point average of at least 3.5 on a 4.0 scale. The scholarship application must be submitted by February 15. It is awarded to high academic achievers, with a preference for students of racially and ethnically diverse backgrounds. This scholarship serves to promote inclusivity, while student's involvement in the program will help to enhance the learning environment through increased diversity and academic excellence.

The President's Scholarship
(Full in-state Tuition & on-campus Housing)

University Honors and President's Scholarship:
Students must be admitted as an incoming freshman to Indiana State University by December 1, 2022 and have a combination of 2 of the following 3:

1. A cumulative grade point average of at least 3.8 on a 4.0 scale
2. A 1270 SAT (Evidence-Based Reading and Writing and Math) or 27 ACT (composite)
3. Ranking in the top 10% of the senior class

Students must apply to the 2023 Interview Day Application. To join the Networks Program, students must be a business major and invited to the program.
